<u> The Indispensable Work of the Holy Spirit in Ministry - Part 2</u>

I. THE PROMISE OF THE COMING OF THE SPIRIT (vs. 5-8)

- 1. The promise is given by Christ (v. 7 "I will send him unto you.")
- 2. The promise was yet to be fulfilled (v.7 "I WILL send him unto you.")
- 3. The promise was fulfilled in (Acts 1:7; 2: 1-4).

II. THE PURPOSE FOR THE COMING OF THE SPIRIT (vs. 8-15)

- 1. The purpose of the coming of the Holy Spirit is to reprove the world (v.8).
 - (A) He convicts and convinces the world of sin (Romans 3: 10-19, 23).
 - (B) He convicts and convinces the world of righteousness (v. 10; Isa. 64:6; 2 Cor. 5:21).
 - (C) He convicts and convinces the world of the judgment that is to come apart from salvation through Jesus Christ (*Heb. 9:27*).
- 2. The Holy Spirit's coming aims to guide believers into all truth (v. 13).
- 3. The Holy Spirit will show the believer things to come (v.13).
- 4. The Holy Spirit glorifies Jesus (v. 14).

III. CONCLUSION

- 1. God equips every believer with the person and power of the Holy Spirit to be witnesses for Christ.
- 2. The Spirit is always with us.
- 3. He will tell us what we need to say to the unsaved.
- 4. There is no excuse for us not to be involved in reaching unreached people.
