Equipped to Witness

Text: Matthew 29:19-20 | Acts 1:8 Pleasant Hill Baptist Church Elkin, NC Danny Dodds, Pastor June 30, 2024 - PM Service

I. EACH BELIEVER IS EQUIPPED WITH A STORY TO TELL

- 1. One's story is about one's salvation experience that brings one into a relationship with God.
- 2. The relationship requires obedience.
- 3. The command requires us to witness. (Mt. 28:19; Acts 1:8)
- 4. Witnessing allows us to share our personal testimony of who God is and what God has done in our lives. It gives us a story to tell. Example: Paul (*Acts 22:1-15*)

II. EACH BELIEVER IS EQUIPPED WITH THE POWER TO PERFORM (Acts 1:8)

- 1. The Holy Spirit's power is received at the time of salvation.
- 2. The Holy Spirit's power is a prerequisite for witnessing.
- 3. The Holy Spirit's power gives all believers strength and ability to witness.
- 4. The Holy Spirit orchestrates witness opportunities.
- 5. The Holy Spirit is the one that works within the believer and unbeliever to bring about the salvation of a soul.

III. EACH BELIEVER IS EQUIPPED WITH A MESSAGE TO SHARE

- 1. The message is the message of the cross.
- 2. The message of the cross reveals God's justice.
- 3. The message of the cross reveals God's love. (John 3:16)
- 4. The message of the cross reveals God's purpose. (Eph. 2:11-18; Col. 1:20-22)

IV. EACH BELIEVER IS EQUIPPED WITH THE PRESENCE OF CHRIST (Mt. 28:20 - "Lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.")

- 1. The presence of Christ gives us comfort.
- 2. The presence of Christ gives us confidence.
