INTRODUCTION- Proverbs 14:34; Titus 2: 11-12

I. THE MOTIVATION FOR RIGHTEOUS LIVING (Titus 2:11-12)

- 1. The goodness of God that gives grace and repentance (Romans 2: 4)
- 2. The grace of God that brings salvation (v. 11)
 - (1) Everyone is saved by grace (Eph. 2:8-9)
 - (2) God's grace has taught us how to live (v.12)
 - (3) God's goodness and grace, which bring repentance and salvation, will motivate us to stop practicing sin and live for God (*I John 3: 1-10*)
- 3. The glorious appearance of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ (v. 13; I Cor. 3: 13-15)
- 4. The great price paid for our redemption (v. 14; Titus 2:7)

II. THE OBLIGATION TO RIGHTEOUS LIVING

- 1. Every believer in Christ must live godly because of all Christ has done for them.
- 2. We are no longer our own. We have been bought with a price (I Cor. 6:20)
- 3. We honor and glorify God in our body by how we live and what we do or do not do (*I Cor. 10:31; Colossians 3:17*).
- 4. We must do whatever we do to God's glory and in His name.
