I. WHAT IS THE LAW OF CHRIST?

- 1. The law of Christ involves obeying Christ's commands, which are based on the principles of love.
- 2. Jesus gave a new commandment (John 13:34).
- 3. As Jesus was the embodiment of God's love, so now each disciple should embody Christ's love.
- 4. This love is a sign to the world and every believer (1 John 3:14-18).

II. How Do We Fulfil the Law of Christ? By loving and serving (Mk. 12: 28-31).

- 1. First, one must love God.
- 2. Second, one must love one's neighbor as oneself.
- 3. Sacrificial service is the third thing involved in fulfilling the law of Christ (Galatians 6:2, 10)
 - (1) We are to serve others as opportunities arise.
 - (2) What are ways we can serve?
 - (a) Prayer
 - (b) Financial support
 - (c) Manual labor
 - (d) Visiting (spending time with the hurting).
