A. 1 Cor. 5:7 - "For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us."

IV. OBSERVING THE ORDINANCE REMINDS US OF JESUS (Luke 22:19)

- A. The bread reminds us of His body (Heb. 4:14-15)
- B. The juice reminds us of His blood (Luke 22:20)
 - 1) Christ's blood was shed (spilled out)
 - 2) Christ's blood was innocent (Matt. 27:4)
 - 3) Necessary (Heb. 1:19)
 - 4) Precious (1 Pet. 1:19)
 - 5) Sufficient (Heb. 9:13-14)
 - 6) Final (Heb. 9:24-28)
 - 7) Christ's blood is the basis for:
 - a) Reconciliation (Eph. 2:13, 16)
 - b) Redemption (Rom. 3:24-25)
 - c) Justification (Rom. 5:9)
 - d) Sanctification (Heb. 10:29)
 - e) Eternal life (John 6:53-56)
 - f) Victory (Rev. 12:11)
 - 8) The blood must be applied through the New Birth.
