I. WHAT KIND OF PLACE IS HELL?

- A. Hell is a prepared place (Matt. 25:41)
 - 1) Hell is a place prepared by God.
 - 2) The place was prepared to be an eternal abode for the devil and his angels, according to the text.
 - 3) Anyone who does not turn away from their sin and wickedness and trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior will find themselves with the Devil and his angels in this terrible place.

- B. Hell is a painful place (Luke 16:23-24)
 - 1) A place of torment
 - 2) A place of fire (v. 24 "flame")
 - 3) A place of punishment (Matt. 25:4)
 - 4) A place of destruction (2 Thess. 1:6-10)
 - 5) A place of frustration and anger (Matt. 23:42)
 - 6) A place of separation (Luke 16:26)
 - 7) A place of thirst (Luke 16:24)
 - 8) A place of memory and remorse (Luke 16:19-31)
- C. A permanent place Hell is forever (v. 26)
